Notice of Intent to Amend Rules of Operation

In accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. §1-121, the Connecticut Lottery Corporation (the "Lottery") hereby gives notice that it intends to amend its Rules of Operation.

Statement of the substance and purpose of the proposed amendment: The Lottery intends to delete § 3(i) of its current Rules of Operation (August 2, 2009) concerning prizes payable for life. Provisions concerning such prizes will be included in the Official Procedures for all scratch games. Manner of presenting views: All interested persons are invited to submit written views on the proposed amendment to Lana M.
