Addendum #4  
Sports Betting Solution and Services  
May 27, 2021**

The Governor of Connecticut signed into law today a bill that expands gaming in the state, and authorizes the Connecticut Lottery Corporation (CLC) to offer online lottery, sports betting in retail and online, and fantasy contests. The CLC’s Sports Betting RFP is updated with the following information:

**Part I, Section B – Schedule**

The Schedule is updated to reflect the Governor’s signing into law the legal authority for CLC to offer sports betting in Connecticut.

**Appendix A – Technical Proposal**

**Adding #6 – Additional Option – Fantasy Contests**

Under its Master Gaming License the CLC is authorized to offer “Fantasy Contests”. Definitions and other information regarding Fantasy Contests are included in the statutory language.

Proposals may include the provision of a Fantasy Contests system and program for the CLC to consider as an option. If included, Respondents must separately describe:

- a. Recent experience with offering Fantasy Contests in the United States.
- b. The relevant disclosures from Part III, Section C, Section 4 for prior performance issues related to Fantasy Contests.
- c. All technical integration that would exist between the Sports Betting System and a system for Fantasy Contests.
- d. Commercial terms as they relate to providing fantasy contests in Connecticut under the CLC’s Master Gaming License. These must be separate and distinct from the Pricing Proposal. A separate tab must be added to the Pricing Proposal file.
