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Resolved, that the Personnel Committee of the Connecticut Lottery Corporation's Board of Directors recommends to that the CLC Board of Directors adopt the changes to the CLC Manager Compensation Plan that mirror the same compensation changes that were approved for Executive Agency managers, including Retroactive Compensation, Annual Increments, and future compensation increases through Fiscal Year 2024. Each manager's incentive award amount will be based on their overall annual performance review.
